# Course Contents of Our language school

## Solid Japanese language education by experienced teachers

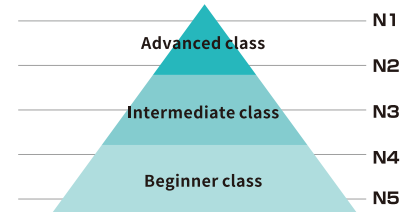
Experienced teachers teach Japanese with details based on the levels of each students to acquire enough Japanese language skills to move to the next level.

In the class, you can improve the four important skills; "listening", "speaking", "reading", and "writing".

In addition, you will learn additional communication skills as well. Furthermore, we give preparatory classes for the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) to improve your ability enough to get the level you need.

In the nursing care course, teachers who specialize in nursing care teach you not only regular Japanese lessons, but also the necessary Japanese vocabulary for care work. The students who go for nursing care technical college or who work as status of residence "specified skilled worker" can acquire the necessary Japanese ability for care work and make use of it in your future.

### Class composition and target level



Even at the same language level there are different abilities each student has (especially beginner class) so we divide classes depending on students' individual abilities.

### We provide special classes for the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU)

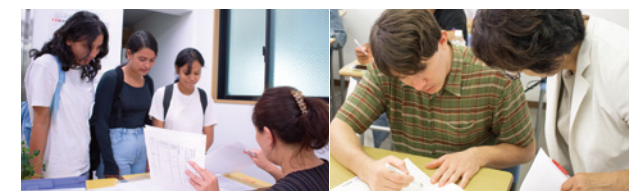
In addition to the regular classes we provide special classes such as science and mathematics for EJU to the students who wish to go to university.

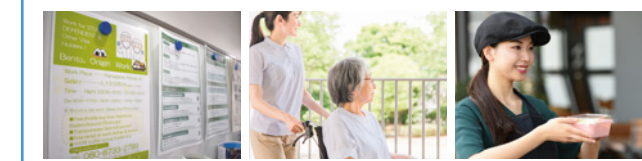

## About part-time jobs

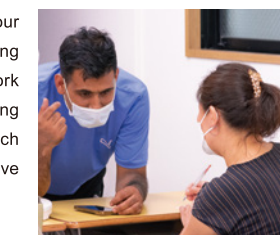
There are plenty of part-time jobs here, mainly in food factories and care houses. All students who want to work are doing part-time jobs
